The genesis of Masai School can be traced back to Prateek Shukla's transformative experiences during his formative years. As an intern at Teach for India during his pre-final year at IIT Kanpur, Prateek gained first-hand insights into the disparities in India's education system and the immense potential waiting to be unleashed. This exposure ignited a passion within him to revolutionize education and create pathways for meaningful employment.

After graduating from IIT Kanpur, Prateek ventured into the world of entrepreneurship, co-founding the real estate startup Grabhouse in 2013. His entrepreneurial journey culminated in the successful acquisition of Grabhouse by Quikr in 2016, marking a significant milestone in his career. However, Prateek's unwavering commitment to education and his vision of transforming lives through learning continued to drive him.

Prateek then shifted gears towards education. His passion for impactful education led him to start Masai School. Prateek's inspiration for Masai School traces back to his travels in Kenya and Tanzania, where he encountered the Maasai Mara tribe.

Despite lacking formal education, the tribe's members were highly skilled in various fields, demonstrating a commitment to excellence and self-sufficiency. This experience resonated deeply with Prateek, fuelling his determination to bridge the gap between the demand for skilled professionals and their availability.

With Masai School, Prateek aimed to emulate the Maasai tribe's ethos by imparting practical skills and knowledge that directly translate into career opportunities. Teaming up with Nrupul Dev, his college senior at IIT Kanpur, and Yogesh Bhat, an acquaintance, Prateek laid the foundation for Masai School. The trio envisioned a platform that would empower India's youth with the skills needed for success in the tech industry.

Since our inception on June 10th, 2019, we have worked for Bharat. 70% of our students are from Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities and towns. 70% of our students come from Economically Weaker Section (EWS) backgrounds

We have made a remarkable journey, evolving from a modest beginning with just 20 students to celebrating our 100th batch in December 2023. Over these transformative years, the institution has proudly graduated and successfully placed over 4500 students in various tech companies. This milestone is not just about numbers; it's a mosaic of individual success stories, each unique and inspiring.

Today, Masai School stands as a testament to our vision, offering industry-relevant education that prioritizes outcomes. Through a blend of practical learning, industry exposure, and mentorship, we aim to shape the futures of 10000 individuals by the time 2024 concludes. We would continue to shape the future of India's tech workforce, fostering a generation of skilled professionals ready to make their mark in the digital era.



Later, she enrolled at M.P. Shah Commerce College, following a conventional path—one shaped more by expectation than passion. "It felt right on paper" she recalled, "but in my heart, I wanted something more."

That 'something' turned out to be technology.

Even while attending commerce lectures, her curiosity about technology grew. She became interested in how websites were built and how code created the user interfaces she used every day. She started exploring on her own—dabbling in HTML, Node. js, and React Native. But without guidance or structure, it was overwhelming. "I was trying" she said, "but I felt lost."

That's when a friend told her about Masai School's EmpowerHer Programme, a fully funded initiative to help more women enter tech. Encouraged by the possibility of structured learning and mentorship, Fatema applied.

Classes began on October 14th. From the very first session—starting with HTML and CSS—Fatema noticed the difference. The curriculum was rigorous, but thoughtfully paced. Each concept built on the last. Within six months, she had transitioned from a curious beginner to a confident front-end developer.

But it wasn't just the content that made the difference—it was the support system. Her tutors, peers, and the Masai team stood beside her throughout. They offered encouragement on difficult days and celebrated small wins with her. "They believed in me even when I didn't" she said. "Especially as a woman in tech, that belief was everything."

By the end of the program, Fatema secured an internship at Curiosity.ai—a role that allowed her to apply her newly learned front-end skills in the real world. "It still feels surreal sometimes" she smiled. "But I'm growing every day."

Looking back, Fatema sees more than a career change — she sees a shift in her identity. Once unsure at a crossroads, she is now charting her own path, with skills, confidence, and a support system that helped her grow.

Though she had learned programming in college, the gap between theoretical understanding and actual coding practice felt enormous. The breakthrough came when she landed an internship at Tech Jose, while still in her final year of college. For the first time, what she was learning in class translated into real work. The feeling was overwhelming. "My family was ecstatic" she said. "It felt like all the uncertainty had finally led somewhere solid."

Now, as an intern, she continues to grow, learning not just how to write code, but how to think like a developer. Every day is a chance to apply what Masai taught her, and she approaches it with purpose and curiosity.

But it wasn't easy.


